Going Deeper

In the film, we see children writing letters or sending videos to Santa. The Bible tells us to pray to God often. Read Jeremiah, chapter 29, verses 12-13 and 1 Thessalonians, chapter 5, verses 16-18. Write a prayer letter to God. What will you put in it?

"Christmas is more than eggnog and stockings" (9 mins). What does Christmas mean to Christians? Look at your own Christmas. Where do you see Christ in it?

At the end of the film (1h 30m) we see Santa give Katie and Teddy his hat. Think about all the gifts that were in the sack when Katie crawled through it (58m). Jesus gave us the gift of the Holy Spirit. God continues to give us gifts every day, imagine it's similar to when Katie is in the sack and gifts are flying past her! Read James, chapter 1, verse 17 and Romans, chapter 12, verses 4-8. What gifts has God given you and which ones can you share with others? Read 1 Peter, chapter 4, verses 10-11.
